In Jaycee Tourney

Young Golfers Advance With Impressive Rounds

Lansing will have four strong representatives in the chase for the state Jaycee junior golf championship when the sectional trials are held at Jackson Cascades at a date soon to be announced.

The Lansing Jaycees had 70 youngsters, 45 juniors and 25 boys, in the city qualifying round at Groesbeck Monday and the top three juniors and the boys' champion, made the grade for the next competition.

Don Leu, age 17 and an East Lansing High School senior, led the parade with an even par 72, while one of his teammates, 16-year-old Lynn Janson, a junior, was only one stroke off the pace with a 73. Earning the third spot for the juniors was Eastern High's Dave Feher, 17, with a 75, after a sudden death playoff with Bruce Klunzinger and Mike Fedewa.

Mike Husby, 14, paced the boys' division with a fine 77.

He is in the ninth grade at C. W. Otto Junior High and 77 was the best score he has ever shot at Groesbeck. He once had a 69 at Portland.

Leu, who did not compete in junior tournaments here last summer as he was in California, had nines of 37-35. Janson went out in 39 and came home in 34 to miss first place by a stroke. Feher won his birth with a birdie three on the second extra hole, after the three tied the first with pars.

Husby won the boys' title on nines of 38-39 and was five strokes in front of his nearest competitor, Larry Zweening, at 82.
